



Having Trouble Paying Your Electric Bill? Help Is Available.

You could be eligible for the **TRUE (Temporary Relief from Utility Expenses) Grant program**, which provides grants up to \$750 for electric expenses and up to \$750 for natural gas expenses for a total of up to \$1500.

Check the chart to the left – your gross monthly household income must be at or below the monthly dollar amount for the number of people in your home:

You must also meet the following criteria:

- ▶ Demonstrate that your electric account and/or gas account is at least 45 days past due and/or have received a disconnection notice.
- ▶ Show that you have made \$25 payments on the gas/ electric account for four out of the past six months.
- ▶ Must not be receiving or have received within the past year any benefit through the Universal Services Fund (USF) or Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).
- ▶ Provide all required documentation along with the application, which should include current paystubs over the last four weeks – or unemployment records or self-certification if no income is available. You will also need to prove that your service is on at the time of application.
